

Marta Zgierska

Marta Zgierska is a visual artist who uses performative photography to explore themes of trauma, liminal experiences and pain. Following a serious car accident, her physically affected body became a tool for exploring reality, questioning the canons of feminine beauty and criticising societal pressure on women's image. She is currently a doctoral student at the School of Humanities and the Institute of Fine Arts at Marie Curie-Sklodowska University in Lublin, Poland. She holds a master's degree in photography from the Polish National Film School in Lodz, as well as a master's degree in theatrology and a master's degree in journalism. Her work has been shown in numerous museums, galleries and festivals. She won the HSBC Prize for Photography in 2016 and has received various other awards and grants. In 2018, she was nominated for the Foam Paul Huf Award and the DZ BANK Art Collection Fellowship. In 2019, she was named Artist of the Year at the DongGang International Photography Festival in South Korea.
