

## Antony Cairns

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Featured in prestigious collections such as the Victoria & Albert Museum and the Maison Européenne de la Photographie, Antony Cairns has developed a unique vision of the city, his main source of inspiration. Born in London in 1980, he adopts an experimental approach marked by retro-futuristic aesthetics.

In the early 2000s, as London underwent a profound urban transformation, Cairns set out to document this change. He works with a compact 35mm camera, which is discreet and well-suited to night photography. Like Eugène Atget, who documented the metamorphosis of early 20th-century Paris, he captures a contemporary metropolis bathed in artificial light and neon.

A nocturnal vagabond, the artist explores the very fabric of the city. He reverses his black-and-white negatives to transform them into positives, then prints his images using digital technologies that are now obsolete. Far from high-definition standards, his photographs emit a diffuse and unstable light, evoking the "darkness of a foggy night" described by Russian filmmaker Andrei Moskvin.

In 2015, Antony Cairns received the Hariban Prize, which enabled him to work at the Benrido studio in Kyoto. This experience marked an important step in his research into the reproducibility of the photographic image, particularly through his exploration of the traditional colotype process, illustrating his constant interest in the dialogues between past, present, and future.

His work combines silver-based techniques and darkroom processes with experimental media. The images thus take shape on gelatin silver film applied to aluminum, on the digital ink of e-ink readers, or on IBM memory cards from early computers.
