

Marianne Maric

Marianne Maric (1982, FR) engages in a subversive dialogue between the female body and the history of art. Fascinated by statues, she embraces a form of agalmatophilia, a desire to animate stone through sensuality. Her works confront the coldness of marble with the vibrant flesh of her models: contemporary women who embody both their own individuality and reinterpreted classical archetypes. Venus, nursing Virgins, Madonnas, icons she desacralizes in order to restore their power, sovereignty, and humor. At the age of ten, after running away from home inspired by Truffaut's The Wild Child, she knew she would become an artist to give shape to her fantasies. Since then, she has reclaimed public space through a liberating sense of pleasure, turning the female body into a sculptural, free, and active architecture.

A graduate of ENSAD Nancy and NCAD Dublin, she lives between Mulhouse and Strasbourg. Her transdisciplinary work—spanning photography, design, fashion, video, and music—has been exhibited at the Palais de Tokyo, Paris Photo, the Athens Biennale, and MO.CO. Panacée. Her Lamp-girls were shown by Nick Knight (SHOWstudio) and at the Palais Galliera. Guest of honor at the Valparaíso Festival, she has also held residencies in Berlin (Atelier Mondial) and Sarajevo (Drac Grand Est). Her work is part of both public and private collections and has been featured in artpress and The New York Times.
